Saturday College

Saturday College has been established over the past eight years and offers a variety of classes/courses for pupils of Chingford Foundation School and a number of secondary and junior schools within the borough and also from further afield. Saturday College is open for 10 sessions each term.

We offer courses allied to our Specialism of Humanities and the Arts, including Art Club, and the Arts Award Musical Theatre Company. In addition, we are running our ever-popular 'Saturday Kitchen'.

Arts Award – Bronze, Silver and Gold Level

Arts Awards are available to all Chingford Foundation School students and give accredited qualifications across the range of arts disciplines in the creative, performing and visual arts. The programme of study for the 3 levels, Bronze, Silver and Gold, are introduced at meetings for parents and students. We also offer Arts Award World War 1 Special Edition courses and Shakespeare Challenge courses. We hold monthly Arts Award Evenings for students and parents. There are also opportunities during the term to attend "drop-in" sessions to assist with putting together successful portfolios in preparation for moderation.

The Arts Award Theatre Company, which involves students interested in Dance, Drama, Singing and Musical Theatre, Set Design and Stage Management, rehearse weekly on Saturday mornings between 9.30 am and 12.30 pm in preparation for productions held at Christmas and in July each year.

The Arts Award Dance Company, which involves students interested in dance and choreography, meets weekly to rehearse for an evening of performance in the Spring term and other local and national performances. We meet on Monday evenings.

We have an Arts Award Young Writers/Spoken Word Club and an Arts and Crafts Club. Our Young Poets/Writers work on programmes we deliver in collaboration with the Barbican Centre and our Arts/Crafts students undertake projects both with William Morris Gallery and Barbican Arts.

As an Arts Award Supporter Centre, all young people between 11 and 25 years of age are able to access Arts Award through our Extended School and Saturday College offer. In 2015 we were thrilled to be chosen as a National Arts Award Good Practice Centre!
