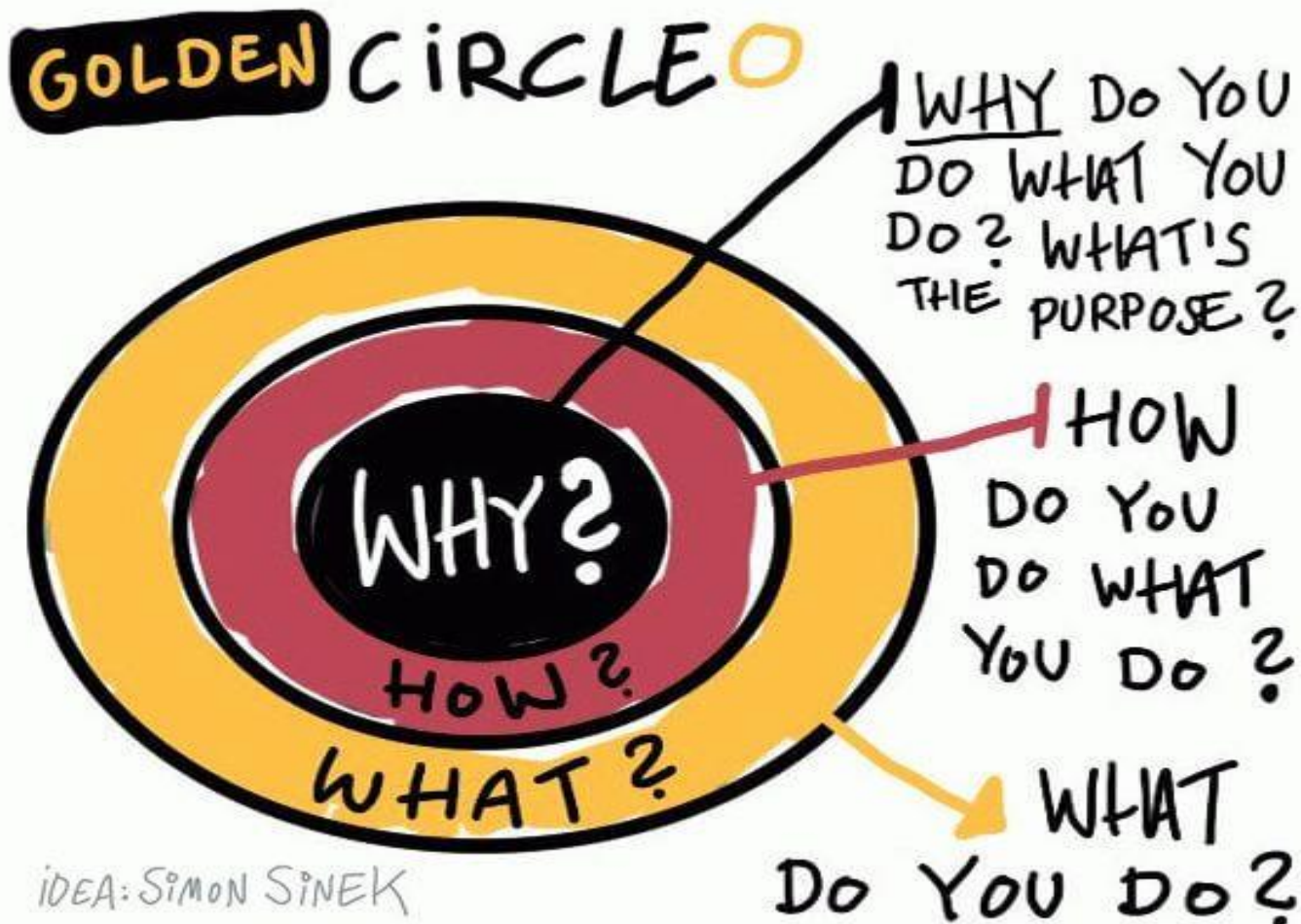

Monday 25th June – Induction Day

On Monday 25th June the Sixth Form Induction Day will take place for the new intake of students. Year 12 students (except Senior Prefects) are not required to be school during the morning. Senior Prefects need to meet in the Year 12 Study Centre at 8:30. Thank you in advance for your help on the day. **All students are required to attend school at 1:45 as part of the Sixth Form Drop Day.**

Y12 Drop Days

On the afternoon of Monday 25th June (following the Sixth Form Induction Day) and Tuesday 26th June, Y12 will be in school and off timetable. The focus of these days will be 'life after Chingford'; UCAS applications, apprenticeships and training.

Year 12 Students Considering Studying Medicine / Dentistry / Veterinary

UKCAT Test – Students applying to studying medicine may be required to sit the UK Clinical Aptitude Test. Applications are made directly by the student online at www.ukcat.ac.uk.

Applications can be made anytime till **18th September 2018**, with testing beginning from **2nd July 2018**. You will be able to book your test slot date when you register online. Students applying to study a medicine related degree at any of the institutions listed below are required to sit the UKCAT:

Those who need to take the BMAT exam need to inform the Exams Officer (Ms. K Cole) by **Friday 14th September 2018**, so that they are entered for the exam, which takes place on **Wednesday 31st October 2018**
