## **Signing In / Signing Out**

Sixth Form students are permitted to leave the school site at lunchtime. Students must ensure they sign out when leaving. This is essential health and safety requirement. Year 12 & 13 Signing-Out Sheets are located in the Year 12 Study Centre and Sixth Form Common Room respectively. If a student arrives to school after 9:00am they are must sign in and advise the Sixth Form Office, likewise if they are leaving early they must advise the office and then sign out.

## **Queuing for the Refectory at Break Time and Lunch Time**

Sixth Form students **can bypass the outside queue** to enter the Refectory. **However they must join either of the queues when inside** the Refectory.

## **Punctuality**

It is expected that all Sixth Form Students are on the school site by 08:35 each morning. Students entering the school site after 08:40 will be issued with a punctuality detention for 08:10 the following school day.

## Year 12 Information

### **Exam Concessions**

Students in Year 12 who had exam concessions for their GCSE's such as additional time for Special Educational Needs are required to speak to Miss Goodman by **Friday 14<sup>th</sup> September** to make her aware of this information. If a student does not make us aware of this information they will not have the concessions they are entitled to, made available to them when they sit their exams.

### **Subject Change Deadline – Friday 14<sup>th</sup> September 2018**

Year 12 students have until Friday 14<sup>th</sup> September to make change their AS subjects. They must come and see either Mr Jenkins.

### **Study Periods – Period 5**

### **Oxbridge Applicants**

Students who wish to apply to either Oxford or Cambridge need to make Mr Jenkins aware of this in the first week back in September. Students also applying to Oxbridge, or doing Medicine/Veterinary or Dentistry need to make their Form Tutors aware as their UCAS references will need to be completed first.

## **Year 13 Students Considering Studying Medicine / Dentistry / Veterinary**

**UKCAT Test** – Students applying to studying medicine may be required to sit the UK Clinical Aptitude Test. Applications are made directly by the student online at [www.ukcat.ac.uk](http://www.ukcat.ac.uk).

Applications can be made anytime till **18<sup>th</sup> September 2018, with testing beginning from 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2018**. You will be able to book your test slot date when you register online. **BMAT Test** – Students studying medicine or veterinary medicine may be required to sit the Bio-Medical Admissions Test (BMAT). Those who need to take the BMAT exam need to inform the Exams Officer (Ms. K Cole) by **Friday 14<sup>th</sup> September 2018**, so that they are entered for the exam, which takes place on **Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2018**

### **PAT/HAT/ELAT/MAT – Admissions Tests**

Students applying to Oxford and Cambridge are required to sit an aptitude test for certain subjects. Students sitting any of these tests need to obtain an application form from Mrs Cole. There is no cost to sit these tests, the deadline to return the form to Mrs Cole is **14<sup>th</sup> September**, and the test date is **31<sup>st</sup> October 2018**.

## **Apprenticeship & University Information**

### **University Open Days**

Students should avoid going to Open Days on a school day. If there is a special reason why you need to go to one that falls on a school day, you **MUST complete a yellow Absence Request Form** obtained from the Sixth Form Office. The Sixth Form will then decide whether to give you permission to attend or not.
