Remembrance Day – Friday 10th November

To commemorate the end of the hostilities at the end of the First World War and to remember those who have lost their lives in conflict, there will be a two-minute silence on Friday 9th November commencing at 10:58.

Signing In / Signing Out

Sixth Form students are permitted to leave the school site at lunchtime. Students must ensure they sign out when leaving. This is essential health and safety requirement. Year 12 & 13 Signing-Out Sheets are located in the Year 12 Study Centre and Sixth Form Common Room respectively. If a student arrives to school after 9:00am they must sign in and advise the Sixth Form Office, likewise if they are leaving early they must advise the office and then sign out.


