Year 12 Sports Day - Tuesday 9th July

Berlin Trip – Easter 2020

The trip involves coach travel to and from Berlin as well as the use of the coach in Berlin, 3 star hotel accommodation half board (which caters for students), guided tours of the Berlin Olympic Stadium, Sachsenhausen Concentration Camp, the Reichstag, the Berlin TV Tower (for views of the city), the Stasi Prison Museum, Checkpoint Charlie Museum and the Topography of Terror. Year 12 Students Considering Studying Medicine / Dentistry / Veterinary

BMAT Test – Students studying medicine or veterinary medicine may be required to sit the Bio-Medical Admissions Test (BMAT). Those who need to take the BMAT exam need to inform the Exams Officer (Ms. K Cole) by **Friday 13th September 2019**, so that they are entered for the exam, which takes place on **Wednesday 30th October 2019**.

Applications can be made anytime till **18th September 2019**, with testing beginning from **1st July 2019**. You will be able to book your test slot date when you register online.
